

# Language Transformation In The Digital Era On Whatsapp: Issues And Solutions Of Using Emojis And Stickers As Replacements For Words Among Students

Employing a qualitative research method and survey approach, data were collected through online questionnaires and conversation analysis in WhatsApp groups. #### Abstrak

The goal of addressing this issue is to identify and analyze the negative impacts of using emojis and stickers in communication among university students. Specifically, this research aims to: reduce misunderstandings by minimizing the ambiguity of meanings that could lead to conflicts, enhance communication skills by avoiding over-reliance on visual symbols that may hinder verbal abilities, promote ethical practices by raising awareness about the proper use of stickers, including respecting copyright, minimize negative psychological effects by discouraging the use of derogatory stickers, and preserve original meanings to ensure that communication remains effective despite the use of visual symbols. These objectives aim to provide a more comprehensive understanding of the challenges and offer actionable solutions for improving communication in the digital age.

This study is crucial for understanding how the use of emojis and stickers influences language transformation in the digital era, particularly in the context of student communication, which increasingly relies on digital platforms. It aims to identify the impact of visual symbols on students' verbal and written communication skills and explore solutions to enhance their interpersonal communication competence. Additionally, the research highlights ethical issues surrounding the use of emojis and stickers and examines the psychological effects that may arise from ineffective communication, which can lead to conflicts or misunderstandings. ## METHOD

The target population for the study consists of students from various academic programs, with purposive sampling techniques used to ensure the selection of relevant respondents for the research topic.

Data collection occurs in two stages. The first stage involves the distribution of the online questionnaire to students in order to gather information regarding the frequency of emoji and sticker usage, the contexts in which they are used, and their impact on communication quality. The second stage consists of analyzing conversations within WhatsApp groups containing students to observe the use of emojis and stickers in real-life communication, both in casual and academic discussions.

The research instrument consists of a structured questionnaire that includes questions about the frequency, context, and perceptions of emoji and sticker usage, as well as their potential impacts on formal and academic communication. Additionally, conversation records from WhatsApp groups are qualitatively analyzed to identify usage patterns and the meanings conveyed.

Data analysis techniques involve thematic analysis to identify key issues emerging from the questionnaire responses and group conversations. The data is organized into themes such as meaning ambiguity, misunderstandings, and the influence on academic communication, which are then interpreted to formulate relevant solutions. The research is conducted over a specified period, including the distribution of the questionnaire and the analysis of WhatsApp group conversations.

## **RESULT AND DISCUSS**

This message conveys two meanings: a joyful mood and a subtle criticism, suggesting that one must continue smiling even when undesirable events occur.



This message conveys two meanings: responding with humor to something frustrating, while also expressing disappointment in a more serious tone.



Based on the emoji '2', it may suggest frustration, yet it is also being used to offer to purchase something.



Without the word 'KACAU', many people might not understand the intended meaning of this sticker, as the text and image are incongruent.



Many people may perceive this sticker as lacking meaning due to its image being overly random or careless.





The image of the cat climbing bamboo lacks a clear meaning, which may cause the recipient to feel confused about the sender's intent.



This sticker does not provide a clear meaning, which may cause the viewer to feel somewhat confused about its purpose.



It is quite confusing, as both the image and the words used are unfamiliar and not easily recognizable.



It cannot be explained.

## CONCLUSION

The results of the study indicate that the majority of students use emojis or stickers quite frequently, especially in casual conversations with friends. However, their use tends to decrease in formal communication contexts, such as academic discussions or communication with professors. Emojis and stickers are generally considered effective in conveying emotions, although some individuals express doubts regarding their effectiveness in formal situations. Additionally, the use of emojis and stickers has been shown to cause misunderstandings in some cases, particularly in casual conversations or academic discussions, reflecting the ambiguity in interpreting these symbols.

Most respondents did not feel that emojis or stickers reduced the quality of communication in academic discussions. However, excessive reliance on these visual symbols can make communication unclear for a small percentage of respondents. It is important to note that the majority of students recognize the need for education on the wise use of emojis and stickers to



minimize misunderstandings, improve communication ethics, and optimize their use in formal contexts. Respondents also generally agree that the use of emojis and stickers should be limited in formal communication to maintain clarity and professionalism.

Based on these findings, it is recommended that students be educated on how to use emojis and stickers wisely through training and socialization. The use of these visual symbols should also be balanced with words to avoid ambiguity. Furthermore, it is crucial to limit the use of emojis and stickers in formal communication to maintain ethics and clarity in messaging. This conclusion aims to support efforts to create more effective, ethical, and clear digital communication in the modern era.

#### SUGGESTION

Based on the findings, several recommendations can be made to improve the quality of digital communication, particularly regarding the use of emojis and stickers. First, it is essential to educate students on how to use emojis and stickers wisely in digital communication. This education should include an understanding of communication contexts, both formal and informal, and how to avoid using symbols that may be ambiguous without additional clarification. Furthermore, students should be taught to use emojis and stickers as complements rather than substitutes for verbal messages, ensuring that the message remains clear.

Next, in the context of formal communication, it is important to limit the use of emojis and stickers to maintain professionalism. Students can be encouraged to prioritize clearer and more formal communication styles, especially when interacting with professors or in academic assignments. Awareness of the potential ambiguities in emoji use should also be raised. Students need to be taught to anticipate misunderstandings by combining visual symbols with explanatory words.

Additionally, to reduce dependence on visual symbols, it is crucial to encourage the development of students' verbal communication skills. By enhancing their verbal communication abilities, students are expected to convey messages effectively without over-relying on emojis or stickers. Finally, further research should be encouraged to explore the impact of emoji and sticker use in various contexts, such as in psychology, communication, and digital ethics. With these measures, it is hoped that more effective, ethical, and contextual digital communication will emerge, helping students better adapt their communication styles.

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
